Id like to take this opportunity to urge you to reconsider passing Lc19. At the very least, to reconsider going statewide thru any forcible measures. I would suggest metro area only, IF the people of the metro counties vote for it, and other counties if their constituents vote to opt in. I would also strongly urge you to remove the wording about giving preference for finance to those counties who have opted in, leaving other counties infacstructure to surely decline and fail until they are forced to opt in.
