Dear Senate Committee Environment and Natural Resources,

Please consider this testimony in favor of strong climate action in 2020.

Last year I submitted testimony in favor of the Climate and Jobs Bill because I feel strongly that we can no longer wait to adress the current climate crisis. I am a senior citizen who feels that we all must stand up so that my grandchildren and all of Oregon's young people see that we are taking responsibility for the ills of our planet that we helped to create in our lifetimes. We all need leaders to pass strong climate legislation that will protect the air we breathe, the water we drink, and the soil that grows the food we eat. We need our legislators to enact strong policies that will provide a future free from devastating climate disasters and collapsed economies.

Please build upon the work you have started with SB 1530 by making the bill stronger and pass bold climate legislation in 2020.
