Senate Bill 1530 is currently too weak to meet the state's goals for reducing harmful pollution and provides too many giveaways to the fossil fuel industry allowing these corporations to continue polluting, as usual, harming our health and the climate. Ultimately, this proposal is too weak to meet the demands of the climate crisis.

Please build upon the work you have started with SB 1530 by making the bill stronger and pass bold climate legislation in 2020. We are in a climate crisis that demands strong climate action. Oregon's oceans are becoming more acidic and wildfires are growing more frequent and massive.

We still need to see changes to this bill. We cannot allow legislation to move forward that is climate action in name only, while it fails to hold large polluters accountable.

I hope you will support changes to this bill and support the passage of bold climate action in 2020. We can't wait any longer. My grandsons need a habitable environment.
