To the Committee,

I am submitting this comment to encourage you to insist on a strong cap and invest bill to address climate change. Climate change is the most urgent problem facing the world today, and there are proven ways to address the problem. Cap and trade mechanisms price carbon pollution using a free-market approach that allows flexibility for covered polluters. The declining cap gives time for getting into compliance, but ensures actual declines in pollution and transition to clean energy.
