As of late last week, my full calendar of work has disappeared, and I'm not alone. We have hundreds of people in the Portland area alone whose livelihoods depend on productions working here. We need immediate assistance to help with housing and utilities relief, unemployment extensions and waiving the wait week for unemployment benefits. Please consider how much revenue flows through the state and it's many communities because of the film industry and the concert industry. This has hit suddenly and without warning, and it threatens our economic security in the short term. Please do what you can to keep us whole while we get through this crisis.
