

Hello and thank you for taking suggestions on public impacts.

We would like to see that title transfers for automobiles are maintained for commercial entities like Copart. We understand removing the face to face contact at DMV offices but we would like to continue to see transfers happen via USPS or other shipping means.

If this is not possible, we would like some options on how to sell vehicles without titles. Would Oregon be amenable to some short-term temporary workarounds? For example:

- Would it be okay if we sold vehicles "title pending" and then got the titles to the new owners upon our receipt?
- Would it be okay if we stamped the faces of the titles with "SALVAGE" and then sold them on a "pass-through" basis so we could skip the title transfer process through MDOT, but still ensure the titles were properly branded?
- Would it be okay if we sold the vehicles on another state's title?
- Would it be okay if we stamped the title "PARTS ONLY" or "NONREPAIRABLE" or some other designation that made it clear the vehicle could not be re-titled?

We appreciate any info you can share.
