I am a small business owner, who just opened her store for the first time on Monday, March 16th. I had projected for low sales, but not for no sales at all.

Due to the pandemic, we cannot have a grand opening, there is no more foot traffic, and many of our fans say they want to come in but want to wait until this blows over. I am only making 100 and sales per day, where I and was expecting to make 800 to 1000.

There is no way that I will be able to continue to afford my rent payments, student loans, or the loan payment that I took out to start this business. With the few sales I am getting per day, there is some hope, but some people are pressuring me on social media to close my store.

Since I am a new business, I don't have the cash flow to be approved for a loan, and I have no collateral to offer. Oregon hasn't shown up as an area on the SBA disaster loan program form. I really need something, whether it's rent forgiveness or a grant or a loan, in order for both my business and myself to survive.
