

I work in the Central Oregon Rental Owners Association office. I'm getting a lot of calls and emails today. Some of those folks will be contacting you and some not.

A few of the comments I'm receiving:

I'm retired & it's my only source of income.

I can't pay the mortgage, insurance and taxes on the house if I don't get rent from the tenants. The utilities are also paid from the rental income.

I have yet been able to collect rent from a tenant that has been evicted for non-payment. I can't afford to let someone be there indefinitely without paying rent.

If the state declares to shelter in place, why can't the state provide funds to pay the rent? This action can cause foreclosure actions and both landlord AND tenant(s) loose.
