We recognize that the Covid-19 virus is putting many people out of work, inducing some of own children in 4 different states.

We agree that those who are renting should not be evicted if they are unable to pay rent due to losing their income.

We provide homes for 8 families. We are not a large property management company. We cannot afford to not receive income for even a couple of months from more than one of our rentals.

We feel it is unfair to drop the burden of unpaid rent onto the landlords, who, in turn, may be unable to pay their mortgages on the properties without some kind of protection in place.

We propose:

- 1. Tenants who stop paying rent be required to provide PROOF they have lost their income. Most tenants are honest and will not abuse the system. There are others, however, who WILL take advantage of the system and view this as "free rent" and "I can't get evicted".
- 2. A landlord who stays in contact with their mortgage holder and provides proof of loss of rental income, is protected from negative credit reporting and foreclosure.
