Project History Summary as of December 31, 2019

In Oregon, RMEF and its partners have completed 963 conservation and hunting heritage outreach projects with a combined value of more than \$63.4 million. These projects have protected or enhanced 832,903 acres of habitat and have opened or improved public access to 134,368 acres.
