

PPE Ordered and/or Received

- Asante Medical Center (Hospital in Jackson County): masks, gowns (quantity unspecified)
- Lane County Public Health: 5,000 N95 masks, 96 face shields & 150 gowns
- Legacy Medical Center: masks, gowns, surgical masks, gloves (quantity unspecified)
- Lower Umpqua Hospital: 10,000 masks
- McKenzie Willamette Hospital: masks, gowns, surgical masks, gloves (quantity unspecified)
- Sacred Heart Hospital: masks, gowns, surgical masks, gloves, face shields (quantity unspecified)
- Springfield Family Physicians: 1,000 surgical masks, 500 gowns
- Yakima Valley Farm Workers Clinic: 750 masks, 1500 surgical masks, 750 gowns, 350 face shields

Equipment and Supplies

- Women's Care: 105 blood pressure cuffs so pregnant moms could check blood pressure at home and not have to go into the office
- Lane County Health and Human Services: Water for unsheltered/unhoused
- Looking Glass: Thermometers, masks, gloves, sanitizer, wipes
- Centene-Quest Laboratories partnership: 25,000 tests each week to FQHCs

Flex Funds

- We have had requests to fund hotel stays for members who need to quarantine post-discharge or prior to residential treatment and are working through flex funds on a case-by-case basis.
- Lane County Health and Human Services: staff to support hotel placement for rural areas
- Lane County Health and Human Services: staff Medication coordination for shelters (ordering, filling, picking up)
- Lane County Health and Human Services: staff assistance helping unsheltered population apply for their stimulus check

Monetary Support

- Trillium provided \$1,200 to Carry It Forward for tents, supplies and assistance to individuals who are homeless. Trillium provided \$5,000 to FOOD for Lane County Virtual Fill the Truck Food Drive and they met their goal of \$15,000.
- 80% of each month's quality withhold will be paid out to providers based on performance and 20% particularly for providers in need due to COVID. Each case will be reviewed by leadership and funds will be approved by the board.
- Trillium through Centene COVID-19 Community Relief Fund will be donating \$17,500 in the form of 500 \$35 Walmart gift cards to organizations that provide assistance to individuals who do not have homes. Recipients include Sheltercare, Looking Glass, St. Vincent DePaul, Carry it Forward, White Bird, Head Start, Cornerstone Community Housing, Centro Latino, Laurel Hill, Hosea Youth Services and the 15th Night Youth emergency youth shelter.
- Project Blessing (food bank in Reedsport): matching donations during a virtual food drive (up to first \$1,000 raised) as well as \$3,000 to increase immediate access to food for individuals, children and families.
- FOOD for Lane County: \$36,000 to expand the school snack pack program into rural areas with 50% or more children qualifying for the school lunch program
- \$5,000 to the following organizations that prevent domestic violence in Lane and Tri-Counties: Womenspace, Relief Nursery, A Safe Space Family Justice Center (Clackamas)

Other Assistance

- Centene program to assist providers with grant writing and small business loan applications.
