## Background

- Mitigating COVID-19 has required that the industry implement social distancing and increased sanitation to reduce transition.
- In Oregon there is a high rate of COVID-19 among the Latinx community (20.9 cases per 10,000 residents) relative to non-hispanics (5.8 cases)
- Inequitable distribution of resources among communities exacerbated by COVID-19 pandemic.
