OREGON BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Oregon Board of Accountancy subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Statutory Requirements³

The board consists of seven members appointed by the Governor for terms of three years.⁴ Members may serve up to three consecutive terms. Members must be appointed as follows:

- Four must have a current permit as a certified public accountant and be actively engaged in public accountancy practice (SULLIVAN, VALDIVIA, WRIGHT, YOUNG-OLIVER).
- One must have a current permit as a certified public accountant and be employed in private industry, education, or government, or be actively engaged in public accountancy practice (ROBINSON).
- One must be a member of the general public (FRANCO).
- One must have a current license as a public accountant under the laws of this state and be actively engaged in public accountancy practice (MORRIS).

Duties and Authority

The board is responsible for licensing and regulating Certified Public Accountants, Public Accountants, and public accounting firms in Oregon. The board has the authority to:⁵

- adopt rules as necessary to administer those statutory provisions, including rules for professional conduct and professional standards for persons or business organizations holding certificates, licenses, permits, or registrations;
- regulate the practice of public accountancy by persons or business organizations holding certificates, licenses, permits, or registrations;
- appoint and fix the compensation of officers to serve at the pleasure of the board;
- appoint advisory committees as the board deems necessary;
- delegate administrative and enforcement duties as the board deems appropriate;
- collect fees as required for deposit in the Oregon Board of Accountancy Fund;
- impose discipline and civil penalties;
- issue cease and desist orders and subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses or the production of records, documents, books, papers, memoranda, or other information necessary to conduct an investigation;
- conduct hearings, administer oaths or affirmations to witnesses, and take testimony necessary to conduct an investigation; and
- · conduct criminal records checks.
