

#### Task Force Considerations

Based on a number of external factors, there are several variables or unknowns that will impact the Task Force in the coming months:

- Compressed timeline to complete activities specified in SB 770: (1) Task Force workplan Sept. 2020, (2) 2021 legislative session, (3) report due during 2021 legislative session (June 2021 at the latest)
- COVID-19 pandemic, virtual meetings, competing priorities
- Meeting frequency and duration
- Funding for staff and professional services Joint Committee on Human Services Co-Chair 2020 Rebalance Plan Agency Reduction Detail (<u>list</u>)
- Task Force Structure creation of and support for two advisory committees, Consumer and Long-term Care, and potentially additional technical/advisory committees (sections 2.10 and 6.5)
