

Item 6: Department of Administrative Services

Statewide Cultural Support Program Update

Request: Acknowledge receipt of a report on support to independent cultural venues and revise the grants awards to independent cultural venues approved at the July 14, 2020 meeting of the Emergency Board.

Description: At its July 14, 2020 meeting, the Emergency Board provided \$50,000,000 of money available to the state through the Coronavirus Relief Fund for financial assistance to arts organizations and cultural and community venues that have canceled or postponed public programming because of economic conditions and executive orders associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. The funds were designated for several programs and recipients, and included \$9,680,128 for the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to distribute to independent venues. The approved grant recipients and grant amounts were identified in the Independent Venues List included in the item materials posted to OLIS under the July 14, 2020 Emergency Board meeting.

Following the Emergency Board action, the Co-Chairs of the Emergency Board received a report that the Craterian Theater in Medford was inadvertently omitted from the independent venue list provided by the program advocates.

The Co-Chairs of the Emergency Board recommend adding the Craterian Theater to the list of independent venue awardees on the same basis as the other venues on the list. To maintain total funding at the previously-approved level, grants amounts to all awardees would be reduced by 2.14%. This same reduction would be applied to the Craterian Theater request as well.

The attached Independent Venues List, dated August 4, 2020, identifies the revised grant amounts for each venue. The Co-Chairs recommend that the Emergency Board approve the grant adjustments identified on the list, and substitute the attached Independent Venues List for the list dated July 12, 2020 that was approved at the July 14, 2020 Emergency Board meeting. This action does not change any other grants or programs approved at the July 14, 2020 meeting for either the DAS or the Oregon Business Development Department. DAS has not signed any contracts with recipients yet, so this action would not require signed contracts to be modified.

Recommendation: The Co-Chairs of the Emergency Board recommend that the Emergency Board acknowledge receipt of a report on the omission of the Craterian Theater in Medford from the list of approved Independent Venue grants, and replace the previously-approved list of independent venue awards with the Independent Venues List - August 4, 2020, to include funding for the Craterian Theater and to adjust award amounts to maintain the previously-approved total funding level.
