Appeal: Chetco Brewing Company's actions were not only unethical business practice but also illegal. (12)An individual may not be disqualified from receiving benefits under subsection (2)(c), (d) or (e) of this section or be considered unavailable for purposes of ORS 657.155 (Benefit eligibility conditions) if: An individual may not be disqualified from receiving benefits under subsection (2)(c), (d) or (e) of this section or be considered unavailable for purposes of ORS **657.155 (Benefit eligibility conditions)** if:

(a)The individual or a member of the individual's immediate family is a victim of domestic violence, stalking, sexual assault or intimidation, or the individual believes that the individual or a member of the individual's immediate family could become a victim of domestic violence, stalking, sexual assault or intimidation; and

(b)The individual leaves work, fails to apply for available suitable work or fails to accept suitable work when offered in order to protect the individual or a member of the individual's immediate family from domestic violence, stalking, sexual assault or intimidation that the individual reasonably believes will occur as a result of the individual's continued employment or acceptance of work. <https://www.oregonlaws.org/ors/657.176>
