- National enumeration progress of housing units is 96.2%
- Includes housing units that are marked for Self-Response, Update Leave and Update Enumerate as well as those enumerated by a Census Taker or at a Mobile Questionnaire Assistance (MQA) site
- Oregon enumeration progress of housing units is 97.7%
- Oregon Self-Response is currently 1.8 percentage points higher than the final 2010 figure (66.9%)

REMAINING 2020 CENSUS TIMELINE

Enumeration of Transitory Locations: September 3 - September 28

Census takers count people staying at campgrounds, RV parks, marinas, and hotels if they do not usually live elsewhere.

Service Based Enumeration: September 22 - September 24

We're working with service providers at soup kitchens, shelters, and regularly scheduled food vans to count those they serve.

Count of People experiencing homelessness outdoors: September 23 - September 24

Census takers count people under bridges, in parks, in all-night businesses, etc.

Mobile Questionnaire Assistance: To be determined

Census Bureau staff assists people with responding online at places people gather (events, grocery stores, etc.).

Process Apportionment Counts: To be determined

After collection activities are complete, Census Bureau experts run and review output from programs to unduplicate responses, determine final housing unit status, populate any missing housing unit data on household size and finalize the universe to be included in the apportionment count file.

Process Redistricting Data: To be determined

Census Bureau experts run and review programs to populate any missing demographic data for each household, run differential privacy programs to ensure confidentiality and run tabulation programs for each state delivery.
