




#### Capacity and Vacancies during COVID-19

Both capacity and vacancies have generally increased during the pandemic.



Because vacancies and capacity have mostly tracked together, the proportion filled has be mostly the same over time, with a slight increase.






#### Vacancies by Age Group

Infant & toddler care was hard to find before the pandemic and has remained hard to find during the pandemic (low vacancies).


High vacancy rates during the pandemic are recently starting to decline.

The market for child care seems to have tightened somewhat more in frontier and rural areas compared to urban areas.






Vacancies.

Child care markets are incredibly local.


We see different stories when we look in different counties.
