## **SUMMARY**

Prescribes requirements for reports produced by Early Learning Division related to publicly funded early childhood care and education programs and availability and accessibility of those programs.

- 2 Relating to reports by the Early Learning Division; amending ORS 329.200.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 329.200 is amended to read:
- 5 329.200. [(1) The Early Learning Division shall report to the Legislative
- 6 Assembly on the merits of continuing and expanding the Oregon
- 7 prekindergarten program or instituting other means of providing early child-
- 8 hood development assistance.]
- 9 (1) As used in this section:
- 10 (a) "Disaggregated" means identified and separated into a group
- 11 based on race, income or disability status.
- 12 (b) "Publicly funded early childhood care and education programs"
- 13 means:

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- 14 (A) The Oregon prekindergarten program;
- 15 (B) The Preschool Promise Program; and
- 16 (C) The Employment Related Day Care program.
- 17 (2) The Early Learning Division shall produce an annual report on
- 18 publicly funded early childhood care and education programs. The re-
- 19 port must comply with the provisions of this section.
  - (3) The division's report shall include the following information for

- 2 (a) The total number of slots available in publicly funded early 3 childhood care and education programs.
- 4 (b) The total number of children eligible for slots in publicly funded 5 early childhood care and education programs.
- 6 (c) The unmet needs of children eligible for slots in publicly funded 7 early childhood care and education programs.
- 8 (d) The total number of slots at publicly funded early childhood care 9 and education programs that are delivered by culturally specific or-10 ganizations.
- 11 (e) For each publicly funded early childhood care and education 12 program:
- 13 (A) The total number of children eligible for slots in the program;
- 14 **(B)** The percentage of children in this state eligible for slots in the program;
- 16 (C) The percentage of children eligible for slots in the program that 17 are enrolled in the program;
- 18 **(D)** The disaggregated total number of children eligible for slots in 19 the program;
- 20 **(E)** The disaggregated percentage of children in this state eligible 21 for slots in the program; and
- 22 (F) The disaggregated percentage of children eligible for slots in the 23 program that are enrolled in the program.
- 24 (f) When possible, the information described in paragraph (e) of this 25 subsection must be provided based on age groups.
- 26 (g) The demographics of the teachers and administrators for each 27 publicly funded early childhood care and education program, disag-28 gregated based on race only.
- 29 (h) Recommendations to improve equitable access to publicly 30 funded early childhood care and education programs.
- 31 [(2)] (4) In addition to the requirements of subsection (3) of this

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- 1 section, each odd-numbered year the division's report shall include an examination and assessment of the merits of continuing or expanding 2 publicly funded early childhood care and education programs or insti-3 tuting other means of providing early childhood development assistance. The biennial report must include specific recommendations on at
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- least the following issues: 6

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- (a) The relationship of the [state-funded Oregon prekindergarten program] publicly funded early childhood care and education programs with the common school system;
- (b) The types of children and their needs that the [program] publicly funded early childhood care and education programs should serve;
- 12 (c) The appropriate level of state support for implementing the [program for all eligible children] publicly funded early childhood care and education programs for children who are eligible for the programs, including [related] state support for projects to prepare instructors and provide facilities, equipment and transportation;
- (d) The state administrative structure necessary to implement the [pro-17 gram] publicly funded early childhood care and education programs; 18 and 19
- (e) Licensing or endorsement of early childhood teachers. 20
- [(3) The division shall examine, monitor and assess the effectiveness of the 21 Oregon prekindergarten program and make biennial reports to the Legislative 22 Assembly on the effectiveness of the program.] 23
  - (5) The division's report must be:
  - (a) Provided annually to the interim legislative committees relating to education; and
- (b) Made available to the public on the division's website. 27

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
