COVID-19 Vaccine and I/DD Population

 Collaborated with OHA to address needs of people with I/DD in Oregon's vaccination plan: https://www.oregon.gov/oha/covid19/Docum ents/COVID-19-Vaccination-Plan-Oregon.pdf

Considerations:

 Unlike Long Term Care, people with I/DD live independently, in family homes or small congregate settings (group homes and foster homes)





COVID-19 Vaccine and I/DD Population

Additional considerations:

- I/DD direct care workforce:
 - Provider agency staff (Direct Support Professionals)
 - Personal Support Workers (PSWs)
- I/DD settings often don't have access to on-site nurse to administer vaccines; smaller, more dispersed locations
- Access for parents/caregivers of medically-fragile children





COVID-19 Vaccine and I/DD Population

Take-aways:

- Need multiple avenues for people with I/DD and workers to get access to vaccine
- Vaccine needed for workforce
- Vaccine for parents/guardians of medically-fragile children
- OHA continues conversation with ODDS stakeholders






2020 ODDS COVID-19 Cases

Adults







Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommends phased approach







Federal Pharmacy Partnerships with Walgreens & CVS

Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNFs) Enrolled in Pharmacy Partnership for Long-Term Care Program (as of 11/15)



100% of SNFs enrolled

95-99% of SNFs enrolled

90-94% of SNFs enrolled

80-89% of SNFs enrolled

<80% of SNFs enrolled

99% of total SNFs nationwide have enrolled (N=15,353)

States with 100%+*
enrollment: AL, DE, HI,
KS, LA, ME, MS, NH, NJ,
NM, OH, OR, SC, UT,
VA, VT

Lowest enrollment: AK (85%) ND (83%) Puerto Rico (67%)

* States >100% enrollment: Numerator may include non-CMS-certified SNFs. Denominator is only CMS-certified 24






Co-creating healthy communities
