Directs Department of Human Services to submit documents necessary to finalize certain pending adoptions on or before June 30, 2022.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

- 4 SECTION 1. (1) No later than June 30, 2022, the Department of Hu-
- 5 man Services shall make reasonable efforts to submit to the court all
- 6 documents necessary to finalize all pending adoption proceedings that,
- on or before January 1, 2022, meet the following criteria:
- 8 (a) Parental rights have been terminated;
- 9 (b) The adoptive parent or parents have been designated by the de-
- 10 partment;
- 11 (c) The requirements of the Indian Child Welfare Act (25 U.S.C. 1901
- 12 et seq.) have been met, if applicable;
- 13 (d) The child has not raised objections to the adoption; and
- (e) There are no pending objections in the proceeding.
- 15 (2) No later than September 1, 2022, the department shall submit a
- 16 report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related
- 17 to foster children describing:
- 18 (a) The number of adoptions finalized under subsection (1) of this
- 19 section;

(b) The resources the department requires to ensure timely

- finalization of adoptions moving forward and any other barriers to timely, appropriate permanency actions; and
- 3 (c) The number of adoptions identified in subsection (1) of this 4 section that remain pending and the barriers that prevented their 5 finalization.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.
- SECTION 3. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-8 ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-9 clared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect on its passage.
