SUMMARY

Directs Department of Justice to study issues related to disposition of convictions based on nonunanimous jury verdicts and to provide results of study to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2021.

Sunsets January 2, 2022.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to convictions; and prescribing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Justice shall study issues related to the disposition of convictions based on nonunanimous jury verdicts.

(2) The department shall provide the results of the study in a report to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than December 31, 2021.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2022.

SECTION 3. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
