LEADERSHIP PRIORITIES FOR POST-FIRE RECOVERY

- *Invest in near-term recovery needs to address areas of high erosion potential, particularly associated with possible debris torrents and public safety*
- *Ensure drinking water sources are prioritized for recovery and restoration*
- *Identify critical streams for aquatic habitat and prioritize investments in those that need active restoration*
- *In coordination with tribes, identify and protect areas with high concentration of cultural resources at risk.*
