  - Priority C (Initial introduction of concept: hearing/s only)

    - LC 270 – Statewide standardization of PPE stockpile minimum requirements
    - LC 279 – Oregon EM Partnerships through incentives

    - LC 284 – Resiliency Surtax specific rate/cap dedicated for Resiliency Infrastructure

    - LC 714 – Veterans Court/s Grants \*\*
    - LC 715 – Apprenticeship funding support: BOLI, OED, and ODVA Partnership
    - LC 718 – Emergency (backup) prescriptions for Veterans paid for by CCOs
    - LC 2785 – DPSST “Pay to Learn” Veterans Pilot program

# HVEP Bills

- Veterans
  - Priority B
    - NO LC – Increase of five (5) FTE staff positions at ODVA
      - At least three (3) managers supporting Statewide Services
      - At least two (2) PLUS Reclassification of existing FTE for a total of three (3) FTE for Housing/Homelessness Coordination
      - LC 2657 – Possible Veterans Health Administration/State of Oregon coordination for Remote/rural Medical Assistance (Vision Therapy Coverage) \*\*
  - Priority C
    - LC 2393, LC2394, LC2395, LC2396, LC2397, – Veterans Placeholders
