

OREGON COVID-19 AAR (JAN-MAY 2020)

Price Agreement between DAS and EM Partners (vendor)

- 12-month retainer, started in June 2020
- To date we have established four Service Order Contracts (SOC)

EM Partners will use the following tools to collect data:

- Survey core groups:
 - Agencies
 - City, county and tribal EM's and LHD's
 - Hospitals and healthcare organizations
 - Long Term Care Facilities
 - Incident Management Team key personnel
- Interviews of individuals and work groups (to include private sector)
- Review of all Incident Action Plans (IAPs) from: AOC, ECC and IMTs
- Review best practices

Three of SOC's are running concurrently but have separate due dates

SOC #1 - Delivered 11 Sep 2020 Review of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- → Establishing: survey groups/listing/questions
- → Completed Final Draft and Executive Summary 18 Sep 2020

SOC #2 - Oregon's response to COVID-19 *Amended 12 Oct 2020

- → Phase 1 Initial State Response
- → Phase 2 Enterprise Mobilization
- \rightarrow Final Draft was delivered on **Dec 10**th and is going through final review.

SOC #3 – State's Joint Information Centers

→ Final Draft was delivered on Dec 10th and is going through final review.


SOC #4 – Re-opening phase from 1 June to 30 Nov 2020

TASKS & DELIVERABLES FOR SOC#1 (PPE)



Conduct review of Public Health Countermeasures and PPE on hand prior to Jan 21, 2020 Develop timelines of Key Decisions:

- → While PPE was under OHA and ODOC Warehouse
- → While PPE was under ECC and on vetting process of PPE offerings to include donations
- → While PPE was under OMD

Evaluate ESF 7 key decisions and resource ordering of PPE

Evaluate PPE operations at the North Valley Complex-Wilsonville warehouse

Evaluate PPE ordering from state to FEMA Region X & FEMA's Air Bridge deployment of PPE

Evaluate OEM and ECC's process to obtain burn-rate from counties, tribes & hospitals

Feedback on providing PPE to vulnerable populations to include BIPOC communities



TASKS & DELIVERABLES FOR SOC#2 (INITIAL RESPONSE)



Continue with the develop timeline from the PPE operations

Evaluate the State's initial COOP/COG preparedness levels

Evaluate the Governor's Disaster Cabinet, Coronavirus Response Team

Evaluate the State's initial response & preparedness

Evaluate the operation centers and their coordination with each other

- → OHA's Public Health Agency Operation Center (ESF 8)
- → State's Emergency Coordination Center (ESF 5)
- → Incident Command Post at DPSST

Evaluate the MAC & MAC-Support role in the response

Evaluate the different IMT structures by organization: OHA, ECC & DPSST

Evaluate the State/s ECC structure & ability to respond to large-scale events



TASKS & DELIVERABLES FOR SOC#2 (ENTERPRISE MOBILIZATION)



Evaluate the operations centers & council, their coordination with each other

- Governor's Disaster Cabinet and Economic Response Council (EO 16-07)
- → OHA's Public Health Agency Operation Center (ESF 8)
- → State's ECC operations (ESF 5)
- Incident Command Post at DPSST

Review & evaluate the EM system for large catastrophic events

Review and evaluate the ESF's structure and compare to FEMA's Community Lifelines structure during the response.



TASKS & DELIVERABLES FOR SOC#3 (JIC OPERATIONS)



Develop timeline of key decisions while JIC was under OHA to include OSFM Type 2 support

Develop timeline of key decisions while JIC was under State ECC to include ODF Type 1 support

Develop timeline of key decisions while JIC moved from State ECC to ICP-DPSST

Review JIC's process, inclusion levels, and feedback when providing information to vulnerable populations, BIPOC communities and communities and people experiencing homelessness.

Feedback on communications from State, Federal agencies to:

- → State ECC
- → Counties
- → Tribes
- → Local public health
- Hospital emergency managers



TASKS & DELIVERABLES FOR SOC#4 (RE-OPENING)



Evaluate the State's messaging on COVID-19 re-opening

Evaluate the State's ongoing COVID-19 response

Evaluate ongoing PPE operations (ESF 7)

Evaluate the coordination between:

- → OHA Public Health Agency Operation Center (ESF 8)
- → State Emergency Coordination Center Operations (ESF 5)

Evaluate the Mutli-Agency Coordination Group (MAC)

- → Evaluate the COVID-19 Response and Recovery Unit (CRRU) on roles and responsibilities
- Assess CRRU's current playbooks and pending draft playbook
- → Evaluate on-going ESFs in the State's COVID-19 response
- > Evaluate the State Recovery Plan and the different pandemic waves of COVID-19
