TO: House Education Members,

This is a summary of the bill concepts that I intend to submit that will likely be introduced in the House Education Committee.

LC #	Summary
<b>1098</b>	Provide grants to qualified public safety and healthcare employees to attend community colleges, public universities, or Oregon Health and Science University.  Limits, itemized deductions personal income taxation. Directs Department of Revenue to make annual transfer of amount equal to estimated increase in revenue fund a Public Safety and Healthcare Personnel Scholarship.
<b>1099</b>	Prohibits student from enrolling in virtual public charter school located in school district in which student is not resident if student's resident school district or education service district offers appropriate online instruction.
<b>1100</b>	Requires that providers of educational services to students of public charter school be employed by public charter school or by sponsor of public charter school. Makes exceptions for other public providers of educational services and for special education and related services.  Directs sponsor to make good faith evaluation of whether public charter school provides educational services in manner that sponsor is unable or unwilling to provide. Requires sponsor to make report publicly available if evaluation determines that sponsor is unable or unwilling to provide educational services in same manner.
<b>233</b>	Protects veterans from diploma mills by requiring Higher Education Coordinating Commission to adopt by rule additional minimum standards regarding source of tuition revenue for licensing of career schools.
