Illinois	DMV and other designated automatic voter registration agencies
Maine	DMV and other designated "source agencies"
Maryland	DMV, health benefit exchange, local departments of social services and the Mobility Certification Office
Massachusetts	DMV, division of medical assistance, health insurance connector authority, other agencies that collect "reliable citizenship information"
New Jersey	DMV and any state agency that the secretary of state verifies meets that requirements
New Mexico	DMV
Nevada	DMV
Oregon	DMV
Rhode Island	DMV and other state agencies verified by the secretary of state
Vermont	DMV
Virginia	DMV
Washington	DMV, health benefit exchange, other state agencies approved by the governor

AVR

AUTOMATIC VOTER REGISTRATION (AVR) IS THE PROCESS OF REGISTERING OR UPDATING THE VOTER REGISTRATION OF INDIVIDUALS WHEN THEY INTERACT WITH A GOVERNMENT AGENCY.

IT INCREASES ACCURACY, EFFICIENCY, SECURITY, AND THE NUMBER OF REGISTERED VOTERS.

AVR ALSO PROVIDES COST SAVINGS BY REDUCING THE NUMBER OF HANDWRITTEN REGISTRATION CARDS THAT NEED TO BE PROCESSED BY PEOPLE.

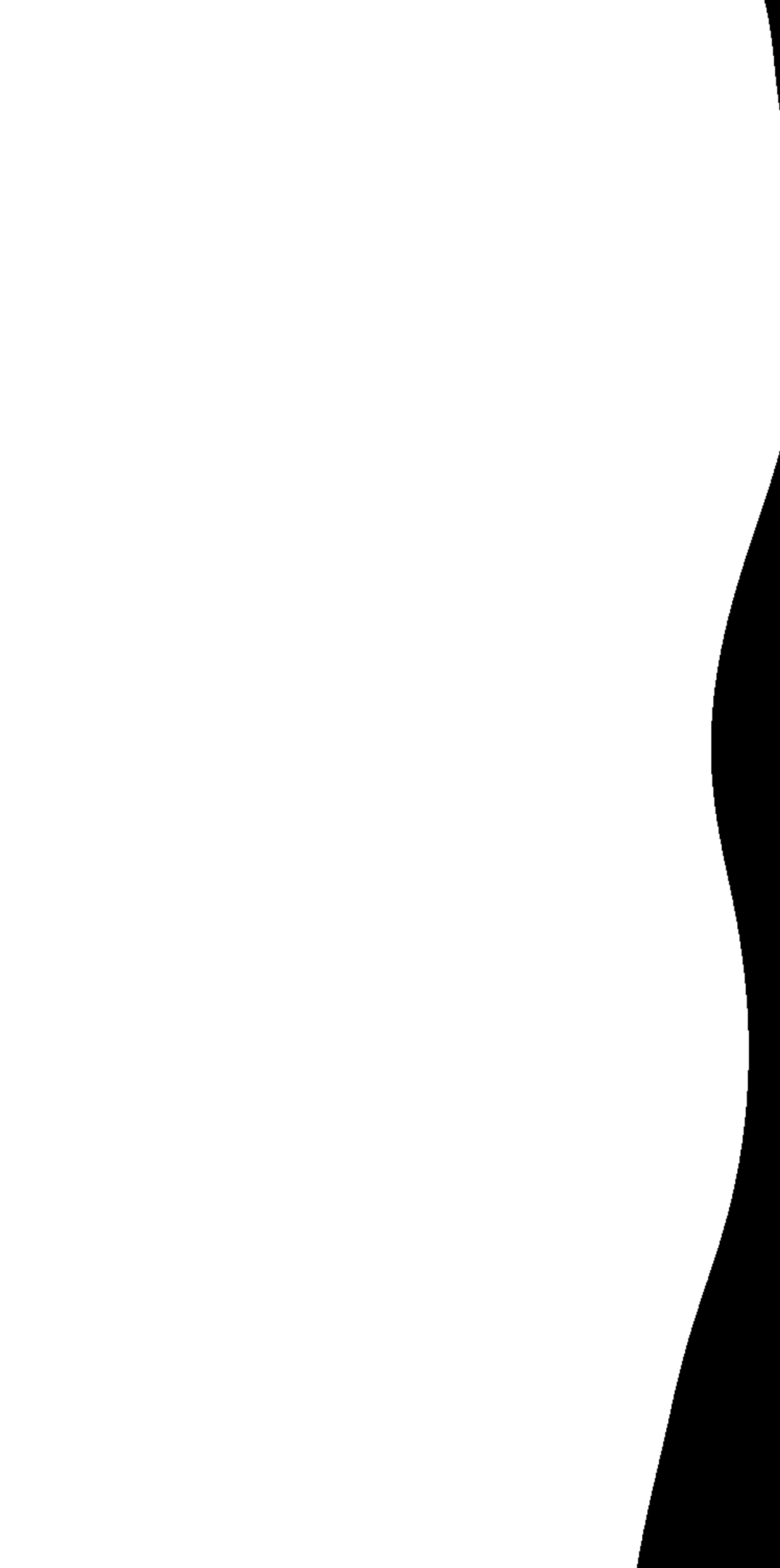
