SUMMARY

Requires hospitals and ambulatory surgical centers to use smoke evacuation system during surgical procedures likely to generate surgical smoke.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to surgical smoke.

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- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2020 Act is added to and made a part
- 5 of ORS 441.015 to 441.087.
- 6 SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:
- 7 (a) "Energy generating device" means a tool that performs a sur-8 gical function using heat, laser, electricity or other form of energy.
 - (b) "Smoke evacuation system" means equipment that effectively captures and neutralizes surgical smoke before the smoke makes contact with the eyes or the respiratory tract of the occupants of a room.
 - (c) "Surgical smoke" means the by-product that results from contact with tissue by an energy generating device.
 - (2) A hospital or ambulatory surgical center licensed in this state shall adopt policies that require the use of a smoke evacuation system during any surgical procedure that is likely to generate surgical smoke.
- 19 (3) The Occupational Safety and Health Division of the Department 20 of Consumer and Business Services shall ensure compliance with this 21 section during any on-site inspection.

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SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2020 Act becomes operative on July 1, 2021.
