Public Hearing

HB 2436

Directs Department of State Lands to conduct study on potential changes to laws, or implementation of law, regulating removal or fill activities.

HB 3226

Requires local governments to allow building across lot lines if owner has recorded covenant not to sell separately. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

HB 3024 **

Prohibits county from considering property tax classification of dwellings that were previously removed, destroyed, demolished or converted to nonresidential uses when reviewing application for replacement dwelling on lands zoned for exclusive farm use.

HB 2469

Allows counties to approve second dwelling on forestlands near existing dwelling for relative of owner who supports owner's forestry practices.

HB 3068 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Authorizes any city to define "area" as city in which property is located, for purposes of certain ad valorem property taxation statutes.

HB 2137 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Extends sunset for tax credits for owner or operator of agriculture workforce housing.

Makes permanent 2018 law sunsetting April 15, 2020, that allows guest ranches to be established on lands zoned for exclusive farm use in eastern Oregon.

HB 2844

Allows facilities for processing farm products under 2,500 square feet on lands zoned for exclusive farm use without regard to siting standards.
