Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 943 A

Allows development of parsonage on land where nonresidential place of worship is allowed use.

Work Session

SB 2 A

Allows listed eastern Oregon counties that undertake economic opportunity analysis to designate up to 50 acres outside urban growth boundaries for industrial and other employment uses notwithstanding statewide planning goals related to agriculture, forest use or urbanization.

SB 287 A

Establishes standards for establishment of farm breweries on lands zoned for exclusive farm use or mixed farm and forest use for breweries that annually produce under 150,000 barrels of malt beverages total with under 15,000 barrels produced on farm brewery site.

SB 390

Allows farm direct marketer sales and consignment sales of olive oil.

SB 408 A

Allows county to approve certain divisions of land zoned for exclusive farm use for purposes of siting utility facilities necessary for public service.

SB 696 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Increases amount of insurance policy that may be required by county governing body to approve permit for outdoor mass gathering.

SB 1012

Clarifies that, to qualify for exemption from land use compatibility statement, applicant for marijuana production license is not required to demonstrate continuous registration of marijuana grow site prior to date of application for licensure.
