Public Hearing

HB 2312

Requires seller of property to disclose whether property is identified by FEMA as Special Flood Hazard Area or whether flood insurance is required by local ordinance or in order to obtain federally regulated loan.

Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2411

Allows financial institutions, after obtaining person's permission, to swipe person's driver license or identification card for purpose of establishing or maintaining contract or account.

HB 2425

Allows county clerk to record electronic record or record bearing electronic signature.

HB 2506

Provides that funds held in trust by mass transit district for purpose of paying post-employment benefits other than pensions are not surplus funds and may be invested in accordance with statutory standard of judgment and care for investment of public investment funds.

Work Session

HB 2398

Specifies that compensation paid to employees of charitable gaming events is based on Oregon minimum wage standards.
