- HB 2417
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Establishes alternate death benefit for surviving spouse of member of Public Employees Retirement System who dies before retirement.
- HB 2646
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Provides that for purposes of determining salary of certain member of Public Employees Retirement System, housing allowance paid to prison chaplain shall be treated as includable in member's taxable income under Oregon law.
- HB 2647
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Allows certain police officers commissioned by Oregon Health and Science University to elect to discontinue participation in alternative retirement program and to elect to participate in Public Employees Retirement System for purposes of service performed as police officer commissioned by Oregon Health and Science University on and after date of election.
- HB 2786
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Provides that district attorneys and deputy district attorneys qualify as police officers under Public Employees Retirement System.
- HB 2861
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Directs Public Employees Retirement Board to provide members of individual account program of Public Employees Retirement System with written disclosure statement about investment options available under program.
- HB 3130
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Exempts retired member of Public Employees Retirement System from limitations on reemployment if member is reemployed for purposes of providing security to Governor's residence or judges or for purposes of law enforcement related to access and habitat programs.
- HB 2838
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Provides that hours worked by retired police officer employed by school district to provide law enforcement, security or safety services do not count for purposes of limitations on reemployment of retired member of Public Employees Retirement System.

- HB 2972
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Authorizes Harney County Health District to offer alternative retirement programs in addition to Public Employees Retirement System.
- HB 3252
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Excludes certain employees of Oregon State Police from meaning of supervisory employee for purposes of public employment.
- HB 2333
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Defines "park model recreational vehicle."
- HB 2231
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Provides right to collectively bargain with State of Oregon to interpreters who receive compensation paid by state for providing interpretation services.
- HB 3389
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Provides that name and address of lottery prize winner are confidential and may not be publicly disclosed by Oregon State Lottery Commission or Oregon State Lottery unless prize winner provides written authorization for disclosure.
- HB 3131
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Permits insurer to exclude from coverage under motor vehicle liability insurance policy person other than named insured based on certain specified criteria.
- HB 2415
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Prohibits retainage or performance security deduction from portion of progress payment relating to cost of materials or equipment stored at job site.
- HB 3109 **
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Directs Oregon Business Development Department to study tax incentives for cybersecurity businesses and to report its findings to interim legislative committees related to economic development on or before September 15, 2020. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
- HB 3030
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Allows professional licensing board to issue temporary authorization to spouse of member of Armed Forces of United States stationed in Oregon and who holds out-of-state authorization to provide occupational or professional service.
- HB 3031 **
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Creates family and medical leave insurance program to provide employee who is eligible for coverage with portion of wages while employee is on family and medical leave or military family leave. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
- HB 3379
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Permits local government to license and regulate vehicle-for-hire services and hired drivers.
- HB 2886
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Modifies law regarding requirement that public employer grant preference to veteran or disabled veteran in selection process for civil service position.
- HB 2423
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Adopts Small Home Specialty Code to regulate construction of homes not more than 400 square feet in size.
- HB 2419
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Permits Department of Consumer and Business Services to issue licenses and conduct criminal records checks through Nationwide Multistate Licensing System.
- HB 2418
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Specifies certain presumptions as to cause of death, disability or impairment of health of fire service professional, public safety personnel or employee of public or private safety agency with duties related to firefighting, police, ambulance or emergency medical services in claim for benefits related to occupational disease under workers' compensation law.
- HB 2804
CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Prohibits retail pet store from selling or offering to sell dog, cat or rabbit acquired from source other than animal shelter or rescue organization.

CARRIED OVER FROM 4-8-2019 AGENDA: Provides that peer-to-peer car rental program shall be subject to same airport fees and state and local law, including taxes and fees, as car rental company.
