Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 383 A

Restricts arbitration award from ordering disciplinary action that differs from disciplinary action imposed by law enforcement agency if arbitrator makes finding that misconduct occurred consistent with agency's finding of misconduct, and disciplinary action imposed by agency is consistent with provisions of discipline guide or discipline matrix adopted by agency as result of collective bargaining and incorporated into agency's disciplinary policies.

SB 298 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5-8-2019 AGENDA: Allows employee or agent of funeral home or person acting as funeral service practitioner named in record of death or fetal death to request certified copy of record of death or fetal death at any time following date of death.

SB 370 A

Requires employer to provide notice to employees of upcoming inspection by federal agency of employer's records regarding identity and employment eligibility of employees within three business days of employer's receipt of notice of inspection from agency.

SB 410 A

Eliminates Department of Consumer and Business Services regulation of recreational vehicle construction.

SB 494 A

Requires employers who are authorized to pay subminimum wages to individuals with disabilities to pay certain wage rates until June 30, 2023.

SB 796

Makes period of absence for donation of body part, organ or tissue "serious health condition" for which family leave may be taken.
