- HB 2263 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success
Directs Department of Education, in collaboration with Higher Education Coordinating Commission, to administer Accelerated College Credit Planning Partnership Grant Program to encourage partnerships between school districts and post-secondary institutions of education to offer accelerated college credit programs.
- HB 2213 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires each community college and public university to ensure that course description for every academic course offered in succeeding academic term lists all textbooks enrolled students are required to purchase.
- HB 2214 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for purpose of funding Oregon's Open Educational Resources (OER) Program.
- HB 2594 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for Sustainable City Year Program at University of Oregon.

Work Session

- HB 2867 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success
Modifies requirements for school to qualify as small high school for purposes of State School Fund distributions.
