HB 2249

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study and develop recommendations on how Oregon's public institutions of higher education can best prepare and match Oregon's current and future workforce with workforce needs of Oregon's critical economic sectors.

HB 2519

Requires community colleges and universities operating in this state that receive state financial aid to adopt written policy on hazing, provide on-campus policy training on hazing and annually report to Higher Education Coordinating Commission number of hazing incidents reported and investigated by community college or university during previous academic year.
