### **Public Hearing**

HB 2640 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Provides that public universities and community colleges must waive all tuition and fees for enrolled students who are members of Native American tribe historically based in Oregon.

### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

HB 2556

Provides seven days of excused absences from school if pupil is dependent of member of Armed Forces of United States who is on active duty or who is called into active duty. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success

HB 2736 \*\*

Allows school district and public charter school to implement nationally recognized high school assessment in mathematics, science or English if assessment complies with specified criteria. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 2942 \*\*

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to adopt statewide higher education equity plan and take plan into account in recommending to Governor appropriations for specified programs, facilities and investments and in advising Legislative Assembly, Governor, community colleges, public universities and other state boards and commissions on educational policies.

#### HB 3032 \*\* **\*\***Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success Prescribes notification requirements for school district upon receipt of report of act of harassment, intimidation, bullying or cyberbullying and upon completion of investigation into report.

- \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means HB 3038 \*\* Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish Oregon work study pilot program to assist postsecondary students.
- HB 3204 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes Dreamers Access Program to award student loans to eligible students with demonstrated financial need.

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success

Directs Department of Education to develop and administer grant program to distribute moneys to school districts and education service districts to create safe points of entry to school buildings.

HB 3280

HB 3241 \*\*

Alters commissioner composition of Higher Education Coordinating Commission by redesignating five current nonvoting positions as voting positions and by adding one additional position for graduate student attending public university.

HB 3391 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success

Directs Department of Education to coordinate with Oregon career and technical student organizations in support of organizations.

HB 3414 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success

Directs Early Learning Division to develop multi-level system of certification of early learning professionals.

#### Work Session

HB 2516 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Prohibits virtual public school from using moneys received as distributions from State School Fund or from other state or local public sources for paying expenses incurred for advertising or other promotional materials of school. HB 2676 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Increases threshold under which school district may receive additional State School Fund moneys for student eligible for special education.

HB 2809 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish competency-based education pilot program.HB2941 \*\*\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to require each mental health provider preparation program in this state to prepare plan to recruit and graduate diverse mental health providers.

HB 3212

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine whether additional legislation is necessary to enhance process of transferring academic credits between community colleges and public universities.
