- HB 2876 Directs Department of Education to conduct study to determine adequacy of public education in state.
- HB 2965 Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine best method for reducing amount of student debt owed by individuals who graduate from community colleges and public universities.
- HB 2967 Directs Department of Education to conduct study to identify sources of stable and sustainable funding for career and technical education programs.

- HB 2760 \*\* Establishes Universal School Meal Account for purpose of reimbursing school districts for certain costs incurred in providing federally reimbursable meals. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success
- HB 2761 \*\* Allows school district to seek reimbursement for amounts incurred from providing school meals as required by state law. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success
- HB 2765 Requires school district that provides breakfast to make breakfast available after start of school day.

- HB 2990 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Student Success  
Establishes Task Force on Family Engagement in Education.
- HB 3010 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes Task Force on Educator Attraction and Retention.
