Public Hearing

- SB 13 A
Changes terminology of certain disabilities for purposes of special education statutes.
- SB 160
Requires public institutions of higher education to provide credit to each student who receives grade of four or higher on International Baccalaureate (IB) exam.
- SB 665 A**
Directs State Board of Education to adopt rules for administration of naloxone or any similar medication designed to rapidly reverse overdose of opioid drug. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Health Care

Work Session

- SB 16
Specifies types of licensed health care practitioners authorized to perform assessments or examinations for purposes of determining special education services eligibility.
- SB 52 A
Requires school district to adopt policy requiring comprehensive district plan on student suicide prevention.
- SB 485
Directs Oregon Health Authority to collaborate with certain schools and facilities when developing plan for communication following suspected suicide.
- SB 963
Modifies allowed and prohibited uses of restraint of students by public education programs.
