SB 664 A

Requires school districts to provide instruction about Holocaust and genocide beginning with 2020-2021 school year.

#### Work Session

SB 3

Permits community colleges to offer applied baccalaureate degree programs under specified conditions and upon receiving approval from Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

SB 151

Adjusts statutory listing of education service districts to reflect mergers of districts.

SB 689

Requires that spouses or dependent children of active members of Armed Forces of United States who are considered residents at time of admission to community college or public university continue to be considered residents for as long as they remain continuously enrolled at community college or public university.

SB 963

Modifies allowed and prohibited uses of restraint of students by public education programs.
