- HB 2883 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-19-2019 AGENDA: Prohibits food vendor from using polystyrene container in selling, offering for sale, serving or dispensing prepared food to public.
- HB 2853  
Requires Water Resources Department to maintain registry of historic-use reservoirs.
- HB 2860 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to analyze ground water contaminant data and provide education in areas with ground water contaminant problems.
- HB 2271 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Changes punishment for unlawful air pollution in the second degree from specific fine violation to Class A misdemeanor.
