HB 2856 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM 3-19-2019 AGENDA: Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Water Resources Department to study ground water in this state.

Public Hearing

HB 2007 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM 3-19-2019 AGENDA: Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule diesel engine emission standards for medium-duty trucks and heavy-duty trucks.

HB 3062 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Extends sunset date for exemption from use fuel tax for diesel fuel blended with at least 20 percent biodiesel derived from used cooking oil.

HB 3065
Directs Public Utility Commission to establish public process for investigating continuing relevance of telecommunications carrier of last resort obligations.

HB 3114
Makes changes to requirements for recycling certain electronic devices.

HB 3182
Requires permit for construction, installation or operation of system for on-site treatment and reuse of nonpotable water.

HB 3325
Requires public utility to meet certain requirements for processing applications from nonresidential customer-generators to interconnect to electric distribution system net metering facility that has generating capacity of more than 25 kilowatts but less than two megawatts.
