- HB 2494
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-04-2019 1:00PM AGENDA: Extends operation of public purpose charges until January 1, 2036.
- HB 2496
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-04-2019 1:00PM AGENDA: Includes battery storage in definition of "green energy technology." Defines "total contract price." Permits contracting agency, as alternative to including green energy technology in construction, reconstruction or major renovation of public building, to make expenditure to improve energy use efficiency in public building.
- HB 2509
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-04-2019 1:00PM AGENDA: Prohibits use of single-use checkout bags except in certain cases.
- HB 2860 **
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-04-2019 1:00PM AGENDA: Requires Oregon Health Authority to analyze ground water contaminant data and provide education in areas with ground water contaminant problems. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2883 **
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-04-2019 1:00PM AGENDA: Prohibits food vendor from using polystyrene container in selling, offering for sale, serving or dispensing prepared food to public. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 3055
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-04-2019 1:00PM AGENDA: Prohibits sale of mattress or children's product that incorporates or bears specified chemicals unless person affixes or attaches warning to mattress or children's product.
- HB 3182
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-04-2019 1:00PM AGENDA: Requires permit for construction, installation or operation of system for on-site treatment and reuse of nonpotable water.
- HB 3326 **
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-04-2019 1:00PM AGENDA: Declares harmful algal blooms to be menace to public health and welfare. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
