SB 107 A

Provides exemption to utility vehicles, when inspecting or repairing natural gas leak under certain circumstances, from offense of illegal stopping, standing or parking.

SCR 1 A

Declares legislative support for closed-loop pump storage energy projects.

SB 914 A

Requires certain distributors and importers to register with distributor cooperatives and provide certain information to distributor cooperatives.

SB 637

Raises statutory threshold for requiring public utility to receive Public Utility Commission approval for disposition of certain property from \$100,000 to \$1 million.

SB 38

Modifies provisions for treatment of renewable energy certificates issued for generation of thermal energy.
