SCR 1 A

Declares legislative support for closed-loop pump storage energy projects.

SB 90 A

Prohibits food and beverage provider or convenience store from providing single-use plastic straw to consumer unless consumer specifically requests single-use plastic straw.

SB 93 A

Establishes dealer redemption centers for bulk redemption of beverage containers.

SB 247 A

Adds containers that contain kombucha to types of beverage containers covered by provisions of Bottle Bill.

SB 522 A

Prohibits person from, with intent to defraud, returning for refund value during one day 50 or more individual beverage containers that person knows were not sold in this state.
