#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2257 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Declares legislative intent to consider substance use disorder as chronic illness.
- HB 2339 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to administer program to provide matching grants to registered sobering facilities.
- HB 2627 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to operate peer managed recovery centers in cities in this state with populations of 100,000 or more to provide peer mentor support and peer support services to individuals in recovery from addiction.
- HB 2624 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes Emergency Department Boarding Pilot Project in Oregon Health Authority.

- HB 2123 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Expands definition of "tobacco products" for purpose of taxation to include inhalant form nicotine.
- HB 2158 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Removes per cigar limitation on cigar tax.
- HB 2159 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Imposes tax on distribution of inhalant product based on percentage of wholesale sales price.
- HB 2169 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Imposes tax on distribution of inhalant product based on percentage of wholesale sales price.
- HB 2270 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Increases tax on distribution of cigarettes.
