#### Work Session

HB 2563

Directs Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules requiring infants to be screened to detect certain diseases.

HB 2220

Authorizes trained and certified dentists to prescribe and administer vaccines.

HB 2609

Requires prescription monitoring system established by Oregon Health Authority to be accessible to dental director appointed by authority. 2831 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 2831 \*\*

Provides funding to peer-run organizations in Portland metropolitan area, southern Oregon region and eastern and central Oregon region to operate peer respite centers to provide peer respite services to individuals with mental illness who experience acute distress, anxiety or emotional pain.

HB 2303

Deletes requirement that pseudoephedrine be classified as Schedule III controlled substance.

HB 2217

Prohibits anyone other than patient from administering medication to end patient's life in humane and dignified manner. HB 2945 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Oregon Health Authority to increase staff resources dedicated to enforcement of staffing requirements for hospital nurses and appropriates moneys to do so. 3075 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

- HB 3075 \*\* Permits duplicate health benefit plan coverage for public employees.
- HB 3074
- Limits rate review process that invites public comment to process for approving rates for health benefit plans. HB 3095 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Human Services to increase fee-for-service rate for behavioral health providers participating in medical assistance programs.

HB 3279 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish uniform payment amounts applicable to medical assistance payments to providers of substance use disorder services and providers of mental health treatment. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 3165 \*\*

Requires Oregon Health Authority to provide planning grants to 10 school districts or education service districts to evaluate community needs for school-based health services.
