- HB 2638  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/14/2019 AGENDA: Modifies membership and chairperson of Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission.
- HB 2563  
Directs Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules requiring infants to be screened to detect certain diseases.
- HB 2220  
Authorizes trained and certified dentists to prescribe and administer vaccines.
- HB 2609  
Requires prescription monitoring system established by Oregon Health Authority to be accessible to dental director appointed by authority.
- HB 2831 \*\*  
Provides funding to peer-run organizations in Portland metropolitan area, southern Oregon region and eastern and central Oregon region to operate peer respite centers to provide peer respite services to individuals with mental illness who experience acute distress, anxiety or emotional pain. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2303  
Deletes requirement that pseudoephedrine be classified as Schedule III controlled substance.

#### Public Hearing

- HB 2447  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/14/2019 AGENDA: Requires Director of the Oregon Health Authority to provide forum for all vertically integrated, nonprofit health care systems in Oregon to collaborate to envision health care delivery system for Oregon's future.
- HB 2217  
Prohibits anyone other than patient from administering medication to end patient's life in humane and dignified manner.
- HB 2945 \*\*  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to increase staff resources dedicated to enforcement of staffing requirements for hospital nurses and appropriates moneys to do so. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

- HB 3165 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to provide planning grants to 10 school districts or education service districts to evaluate community needs for school-based health services.
- HB 3075 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Permits duplicate health benefit plan coverage for public employees.
