- HB 3192 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Imposes annual assessment on manufacture of prescription opioids.
- HB 2678
Subject to exceptions, allows Oregon Health Authority to require prior authorization for prescription drugs, other than mental health drugs, that are not listed on Practitioner-Managed Prescription Drug Plan and that are reimbursed on fee-for-service basis.
- HB 2638
CARRIED OVER FROM 03/19/2019 AGENDA: Modifies membership and chairperson of Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission.

Public Hearing

- HB 3093 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires pharmaceutical manufacturers to report to Department of Consumer and Business Services total cost of patient assistance programs and information on financial assistance provided to pharmacies, government agencies and advocacy organizations.
- HB 2840
Establishes prohibitions for registered pharmacy benefit managers.
- HB 2185
Imposes new requirements on pharmacy benefit managers registered in this state.
- HB 3273 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs each manufacturer of prescription drugs that are sold within this state to develop and implement drug take-back program for purpose of collecting from individuals and nonbusiness entities prescription drugs for disposal.
