HB 3165 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Oregon Health Authority to provide planning grants to 10 school districts or education service districts to evaluate community needs for school-based health services.

HB 3075 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Permits duplicate health benefit plan coverage for public employees.

HB 2986 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organizations to partner with regional health equity coalitions in addressing health disparities for communities of color.

HB 2267

Requires Oregon Health Authority to report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health, no later than September 20, 2020, on implementation of provisions requiring coordinated care organization governing boards to be more transparent.

#### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

HB 3279 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish uniform payment amounts applicable to medical assistance payments to providers of substance use disorder services and providers of mental health treatment.

HB 3095 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Human Services to increase fee-for-service rate for behavioral health providers participating in medical assistance programs.

HB 3192 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Imposes annual assessment on manufacture of prescription opioids.
