HB 3262 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Imposes assessment on large employers with employees who receive or who have minor children who receive certain types of public assistance in this state, in amount equal to public assistance paid.

HB 2269

Requires Oregon Health Authority, in consultation with stakeholders, to propose to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health, by January 1, 2020, long term solutions to financing health care in Oregon.

Requires nonprofit hospitals and hospital systems to establish financial assistance policies meeting specified criteria.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM 03/26/2019 AGENDA: Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish uniform payment amounts applicable to medical assistance payments to providers of substance use disorder services and providers of mental health treatment.

HB 3095 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM 03/26/2019 AGENDA: Directs Department of Human Services to increase fee-for-service rate for behavioral health providers participating in medical assistance programs.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Oregon Health Authority to provide planning grants to 10 school districts or education service districts to evaluate community needs for school-based health services.
